CANNABIS OIL

HEMP OIL

PRODUCT:
Hemp bi-product.

LABELS:
Must state that is is made
from hemp.

TESTING:
Due to lax testing
outside the U.S.
products may be
highly contaminated.

INGREDIENTS
GMO's, tranfats & additives

EXTRACTION:
BHO, propane, hexane
or hydrocarbons.

HEMP:
Typically low in cannabinoid content. A huge amount
of hemp is required to extract a small amount of
CBD, raising the risk of contaminants because hemp,
a bioaccumulator, draws toxins from the soil.

CANNABIS OIL

PRODUCT:
High level CBD. For maximum
therapeutic impact, choose both
CBD and THC product.

LABELS:
Show ratio of CBD/THC,
a manufacturing date
and batch number.

TESTING:
Tested for consistency.

INGREDIENTS:
No corn syrup, GMO's,
tranfats or additives.

EXTRACTION:
Non-toxic, supercritical CO2.

CANNABIS:
The robust terpene profile
of whole plant cannabis enhances
the therapeutic benefits of CBD and THC.
